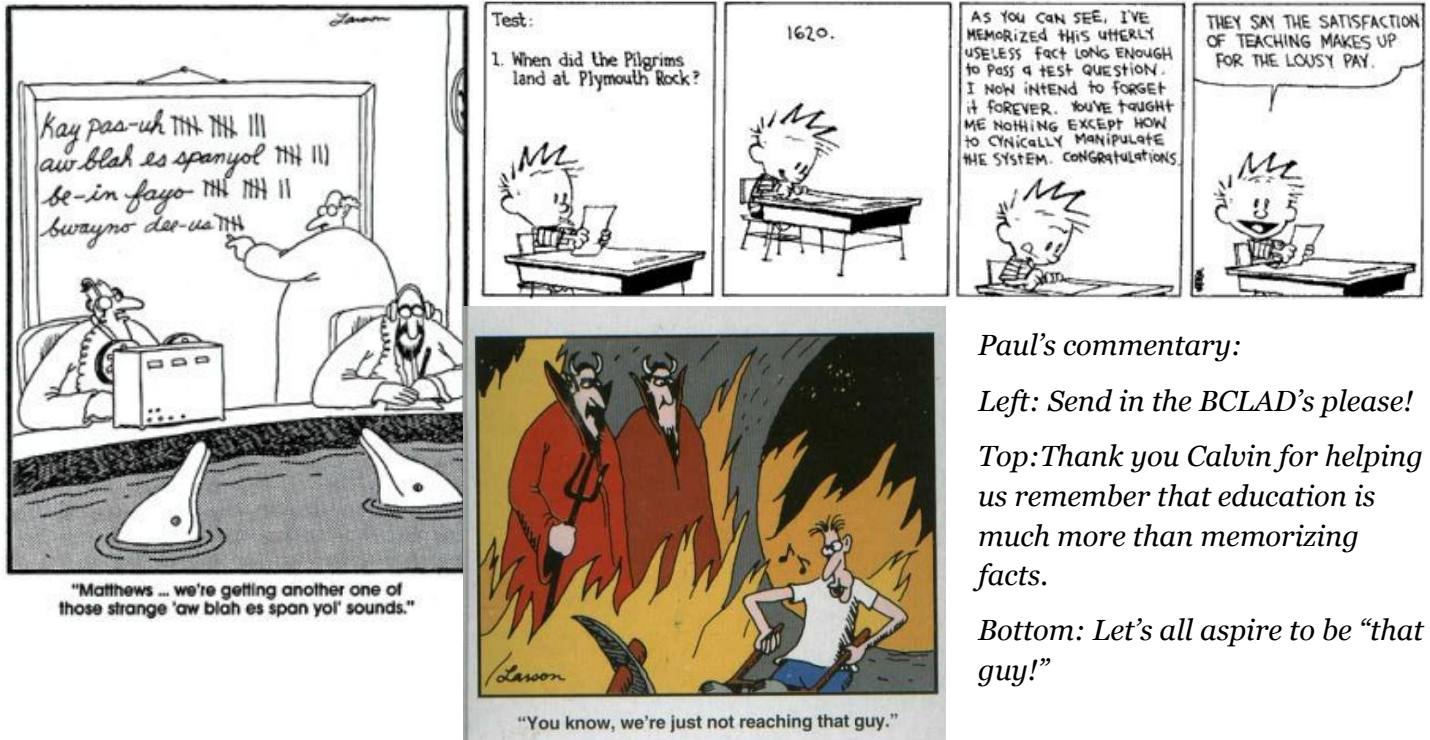
And we do still manage to have fun, even in class. Just check out all this cool Play-doh art!
