The Department of Education at the University of California, Irvine invites applications for an open rank tenure-track position in the areas of college access and/or higher education. Successful candidates must possess a Ph.D. (or equivalent) by July 1, 2012, and have demonstrated excellence in research and teaching. Applications will be considered at the Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, or Full Professor levels.

We invite applicants from a broad range of disciplines with research interests related to student experiences in gaining access to or participating in all levels of higher education, from community college to graduate studies. Possible research areas may include, but are not limited to, higher education policy, college access, college persistence and completion, inequalities in post-secondary outcomes, institutional change and evaluation, language and literacy development in higher education, or the use of digital media and online instruction. Scholars whose work bridges disciplinary boundaries are particularly encouraged to apply.

The selected candidate will be expected to contribute to our graduate and undergraduate programs, and particularly to our Ph.D. in Education program, which offers specializations in Educational Policy and Social Context; Language, Literacy, and Technology; and Learning, Cognition and Development. We are a dynamic and fast growing department that plans to soon transition into a School of Education.
